

Excursion to Olama Canyon

Distance & duration: average 1 km, depending on how far you go

Elevation: 0 meters

Trail difficulty: Easy

Take with you: good shoes, swimsuit

Highlights: river, rock formations, small waterfalls

Signs on trail: No, the path is visible

1. Go tot the Muy Muy bus station. You can walk there, hitch hike or take a taxi.
2. Take the bus or taxi to Boaco. Get off at the Olama bridge (about 15 minutes).
3. At the entrance, turn right, pass below the bridge to the left and follow the path.
4. Now just follow the river to the canyon. You can go as far as you want.
5. Want to go back? Just stand a long side the road and wait for a bus or taxi to Muy Muy or hitch hike back.

*It can occur that local people tell you it's too dangerous or not to go. In almost every case this is not true. But to be safe, go with the two or in a group.
