## **Coffee Trail**

Interested in looking at a river, a natural spring and a coffee field? In between the coffee trees are many other shade trees, like cacoa, oranges, avocados, grapefruits etc. You can even spot monkeys or sloths.

- 1. Facing the reception go right, walking towards the "Beneficio".
- 2. You will find a small path going downhill towards the river behind the Beneficio.
- 3. Follow the red signs and cross the river. Go up again on the other side. When you reach the coffee field, keep left. Then go right up a small slope.
- 4. As soon as you get to a Y-junction, with a tree with a red arrow in the middle, go right.
- 5. Follow the red signs and turn left on a bigger path. Almost at the end of the path, go left.
- 6. Reaching an arrow on a rock, follow red signs to the right while passing the yellow bamboo on the left.
- 7. After a short while you will have reached the Pozo Azul. It is a fresh water spring and provides drinking water for the houses there.
- 8. Cross the creak over the wooden bridge and go through the gate following the red signs throughout the private property.
- 9. Walk towards the house, keep left and cross the creak again before reaching a second house. Go around this house and follow the path down through the fields.
- 10. Continue on the path, pass a small waterfall (only in rainy season) and cross the river again.
- 11. Now you go uphill towards the main house, passing it on the right side and coming back to the roundabout.
